EYFS	<p>Understanding the World: People & Communities</p> <p>In EYFS, children will learn about a range of people and communities. They develop concepts of pattern and sequence through exploring shape, space and measure, look at growth over time, change, things from their own past, what they were like as babies and how they are the same or different to now. The children will be introduced to vocabulary such as ‘yesterday,’ ‘today’ and ‘tomorrow’ to introduce the concept of time and sequencing.</p> <p>There will be a focus on one significant individual or one significant event.</p>
