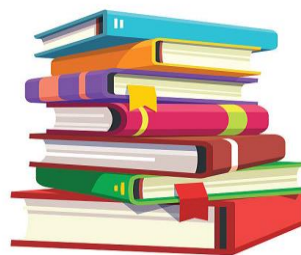
Book Fayre
